Mike Angley takes pride in the many accomplishments he's enjoyed in his personal and professional life. First and foremost, he's a husband of thirty-two years to the former Ms. Evelyn Nunez-Sanchez from Mayaguez, PR, herself a U.S. Air Force veteran. They have three adult children, all currently residing in Colorado. Mike is a Conservative Christian whose faith inspires and informs his life. He fashions himself as a traditional conservative, crafted in the image of President Ronald Reagan for whom he proudly cast his first-ever presidential vote.

Law Enforcement and Intelligence Community Executive

Mike's law enforcement career was extensive and varied. He rose to the rank of Colonel (O-6), becoming an Executive in Federal Law Enforcement and U.S. Intelligence. He served over 25 years as a Senior Supervisory Special Agent with the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (OSI) (sister agency to the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS)), conducting complex felony criminal and fraud investigations and counterintelligence and counterterrorism operations.

He routinely was recognized as a decisive, strategic leader and consistently was rated among the "Top 1%" of USAF officers. He has held assignments in the United States, Far East Asia, the Middle East and at national, theater, and joint levels.

He was a Special Agent in Charge (SAC/Commander) five different assignments in the U.S. and overseas. At his career pinnacle, he led 150 federal agents conducting law enforcement and CI

operations at 13 geographically-separated units throughout the U.S. He oversaw a \$5M annual operations budget, to include \$40K in confidential funds. He has supervised and mentored hundreds of young men and women airmen, Special Agents, and civilian professionals during his tenure.

Some of his career successes include:

- Decorated by the Korean President and the National Police Agency Commissioner for identifying, targeting, and neutralizing a Middle East terrorist cell operating in Seoul before it carried out its mission.
- Led U.S.-Japan counter-narcotics operations that eradicated \$8M of drugs meant for sale to military members.
- Countered a Soviet KGB agent's efforts to steal critical U.S. technology and stymied Russian military progress for years.
- Recovered over \$2.7M U.S. taxpayer dollars lost through complex international fraud schemes.
- Commanded Middle East counterterrorism operations that successfully neutralized a terrorist cell targeting Department of Defense (DoD) officials.
- Led a special counterintelligence unit the White House cited as second-best organization in the entire U.S. Intelligence Community in a 1999 award. A DoD inspector said this unit was the "best CI shop among all the Unified Commands" in the Defense Department worldwide.

Education & Professional Development

Mike values education and believes it is the cornerstone to professional development. He plans to formalize education in the El Paso County Sheriff's Office because he knows as a mentor how much it will help a young deputy grow as a leader.

He holds a Master's degree in National Security Affairs from the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA and a Bachelor's degree in both Criminal Justice and Psychology (double major) from King's College in Wilkes-Barre, PA. Mike also is an Honor Graduate of the Defense Language Institute's Korean language program and a Distinguished Graduate of the Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps.

He demonstrated his love of continuing education by example while in the Air Force. Mike completed all three levels of his Professional Military Education BOTH by correspondence and

in-residence. For his Senior Developmental Education (vital to making Colonel), Mike was selected for a coveted National Defense Fellowship program at Florida International University in Miami, FL. While there he served as Adjunct Professor of International Relations and he partnered with a State Department Fellow on a variety of projects involving national security and terrorism. He also graduated from the National Defense University Armed Forces Staff College's joint education program.

Multi-Dimensional Second Career

After his Air Force career, Mike set out in two directions at the same time. First, he went into academia and served for ten years as the Senior Military Advisor to the President of Henley-Putnam University in San Jose, CA. Henley-Putnam is a Strategic Security school that was founded by a group of former senior law enforcement and intelligence community professionals and it caters to the same group of '*badges and spooks*' Mike spent a career working with.
